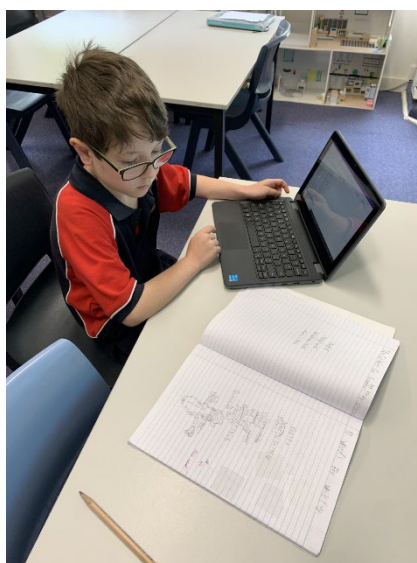
### NEW CHICKS

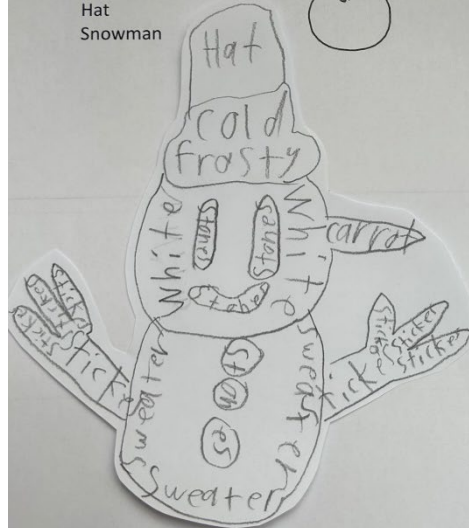
